How to order:

Example: Bypass valve to work in pumps from 30cc to 60cc; pressures 350/400 bar → BP3060H

Important notes:

Every time the vehicle is in motion; the solenoid should be off, this way allowing the bypass to work correctly.
When an open centre circuit valve is being used in the system and the solenoid is off (bypass function), at least 5 l/min should come out from the pressure line directly to the tank. This procedure will prevent the hydraulic system from overheating while the vehicle is working.

-If a closed centre circuit valve is installed in the system a tube/pipe must be installed from the drain point of the bypass valve directly to the tank.

If these instructions aren't followed, the system will overheat and cause its rupture.
